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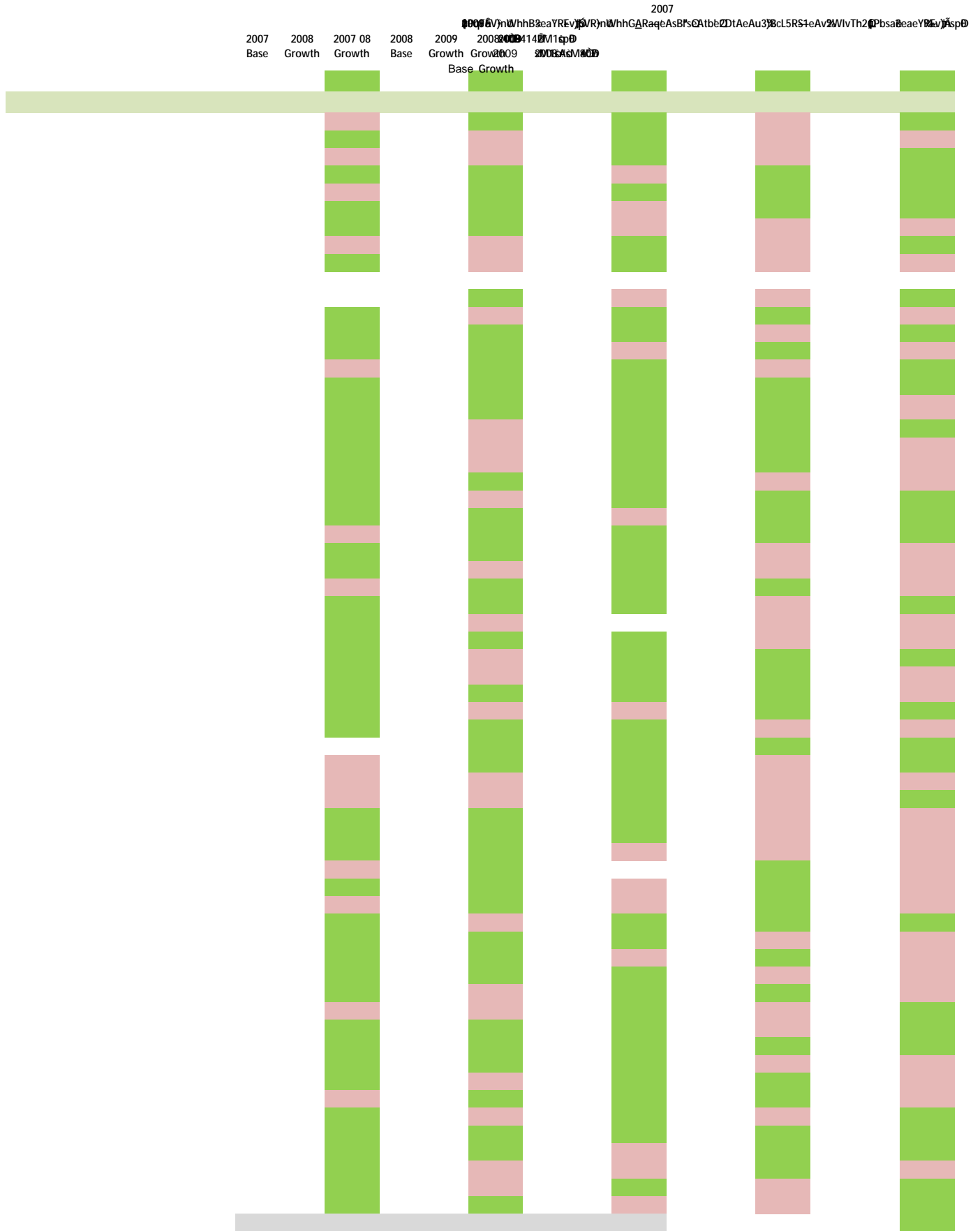

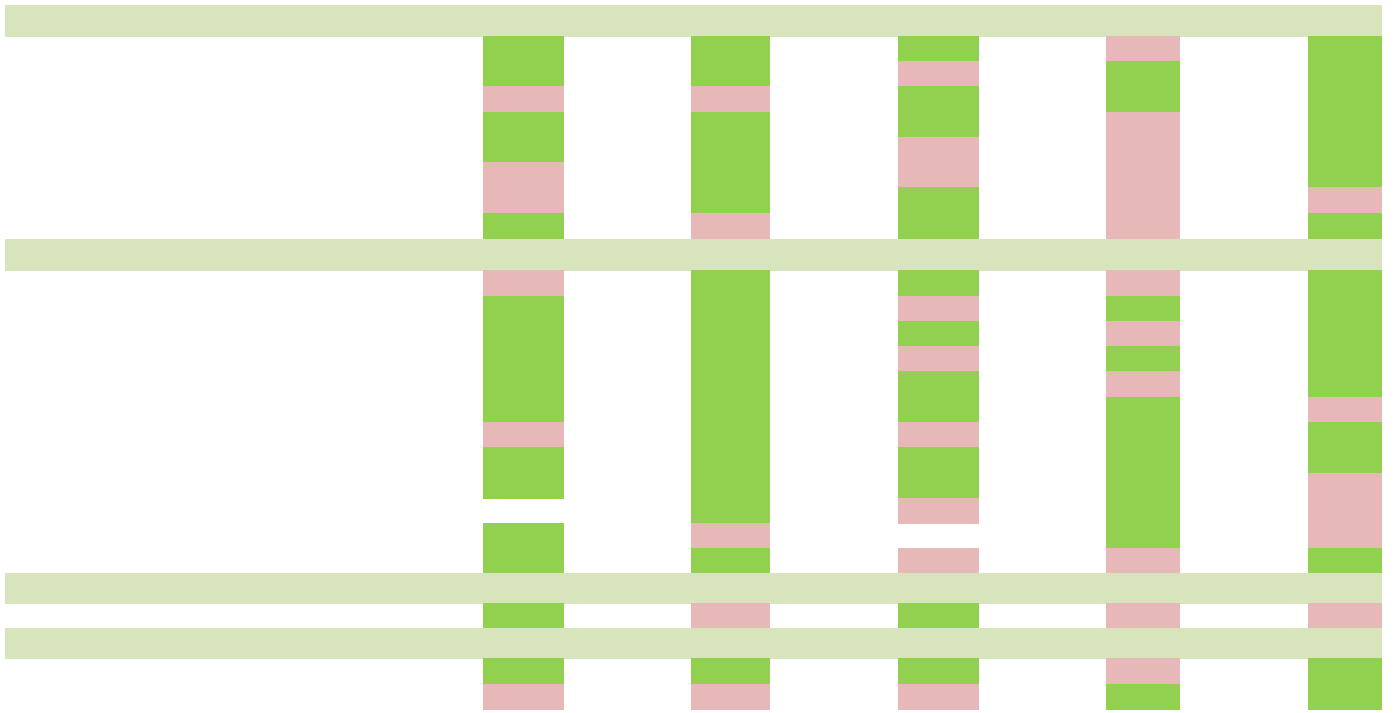
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Sacramento City Unified District Academic Performance Index (API) Base and Growth by District and Schoolwide Five-Year Comparison

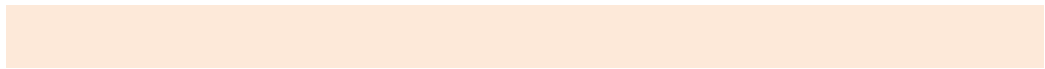

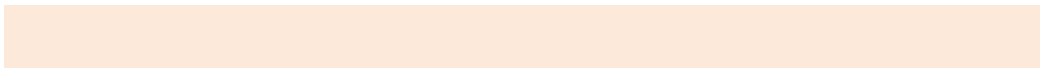
