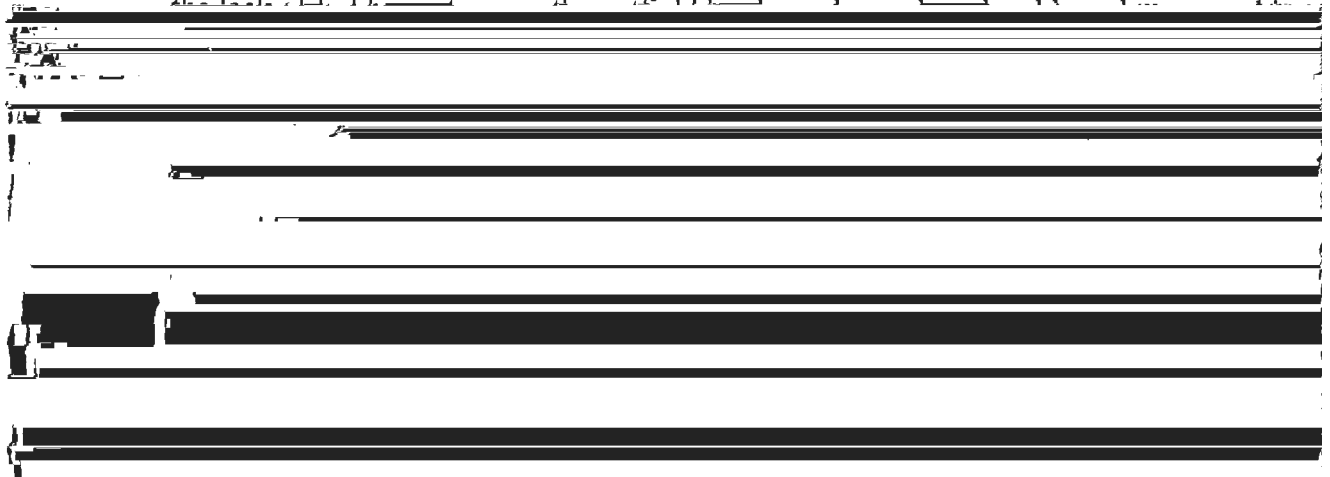



Comment: Dear Superintendent, School Board Members, and Councilmember,

I'm writing today as a concerned parent of a John F. Kennedy high school student who plays baseball at the school. Last year, during the COVID-shortened season, the condition of the fields was bordering on dangerous, with: gopher holes; dry patchy grass; and uneven playing surfaces. Understanding that the fields were poorly maintained due to COVID shutdowns and staffing shortages, we parents did what we could to get the field in somewhat playable condition.

However, upon returning to the school this fall, we found that gophers have now overrun the baseball and softball fields creating tunnels, sinkholes, ramps and valleys and sections of dead grass that we have had to [redacted]
