

Fee Schedule

Fee rates for Facility Use Fees and Asa will be reassessed annually for federal, state, and local tax rates, employee compensation, or utility rate increases. Wagesistrict employees (custodians, cafeteria workers, etc.) will be charged for Classification "A" (Subsidizeds)ers for use of a facility that occurs during off hours/weekends/holidays. The rate charged will be per with a two-hour minimum during weekdays, four hour minimum during weekends and holidays.

Facility Use fees for all other classificationers are listed on the attached schedule.

Application for Use of Facilities

The Superintendent or designee shall maintain applied procedures and regulations for the use of school facilities which: (Education Code 40042)

- 1. Encourage and assist groups desiring to use school facilities for approved activities.
- 2. Preserve order in school buildings and on schoolings, and protect school facilities. If necessary, a person may be designated to supervise this task.
- 3. Ensure that the use of facilities or grounds is **inco**nsistent with the use of the school facilities or grounds for school purposes and does not interwite the regular conduct of school work.

Persons or organizations applying for the use **bost** facilities shall submit a statement of information indicating that the organization upholds the statef **add** constitutions and **ds** not intend to use school

- 8. Mass care and welfare shelters during disastemsher emergencies affecting the public health and welfare (cf. 3516 Emergencies and Disaster Preparedness Plan)
- 9. Other purposes deemed appropriate by the Governing Board

Restrictions

School facilities shall not be used for any of the following activities:

- 1. Any use by an individual or group for the commission of any crime or any act prohibited by law.
- 2. Any use of school facilities or grounds which isonsistent with their use for school purposes or which interferes with the regular conduct of school or school work.
- 3. Any use which is discriminatory in the legal ser(sé.0410 Nondiscrimination in District Programs and Activities)
- 4. Any use which involves the possession, consumptiosaler of alcoholic beverages or any restricted substances on school property.

Fair Rental Value

Groups shall be charged fair rental value when usingos facilities or grounds for entertainment or meetings where admission is charged or ordinations solicited and net receipts around to be expended for charitable purposes or for the welfare of the district's students. (Education Code 38134)

The district shall charge fair rental value for religious anizations conducting events that are not exclusively religious services including (but not limited to) fundraisers, car washes, etc.

Damage and Liability

Groups or persons using school facilities shall be lifetileny property damages caused by the activity. The Board may charge the amount necessary to repaid at may deny the group further use of school facilities.

Any group using school facilities shall be liable for ariyunines resulting from its neigence during such use. The group shall bear the cost of insuring against this miskatefending itself against claims arising from this risk.

Groups other than those that promote youth and school activities shall be required to include the district as additional insured on their liability policies.

The Superintendent or designee may require a hold has radgreement when warranted by the type of activity or the specific facility being used.

Application for Use of Facilities
