Administrative Services Approve 2011-2012 District Budget Update and Revision – State Budget Approval August 4, 2011

Should the worst case scenario occur, districts have the authority to shorten the school year by up to seven days in addition to the five days authorized by current law. A shorter school year must be bargained with our union partners and implemented prior to the end of the 2011-12 fiscal year.

Finally, cash deferrals that were proposed in the Governor's January budget and rescinded in the May Revision were restored. This means that our cash position is negatively impacted as we receive funds due to us later than anticipated. As a result, Tax Revenue a
