

Comparable Performance (District determines comparable performance)	PS7's performance is at least equal to that of other schools students would attend	Fourth highest performing school in SCUSD by API










#### Mission

To create one of the finest urban public K-8 schools in America


#### Choice and Commitment Enrollment over time



\*Number for 2012-13 is projected based off of enrollment lottery results from March. PS7 had eight lotteries.




#### End of Trimester Parent Survey Results







# **CST Results**


PS7 students in all grades outperform students across the state of California in ELA (reading) and math. Below are the percent of students proficient or advanced in each.




PS7 students participate in various experiences that extend beyond the basic classroom skills and subjects





