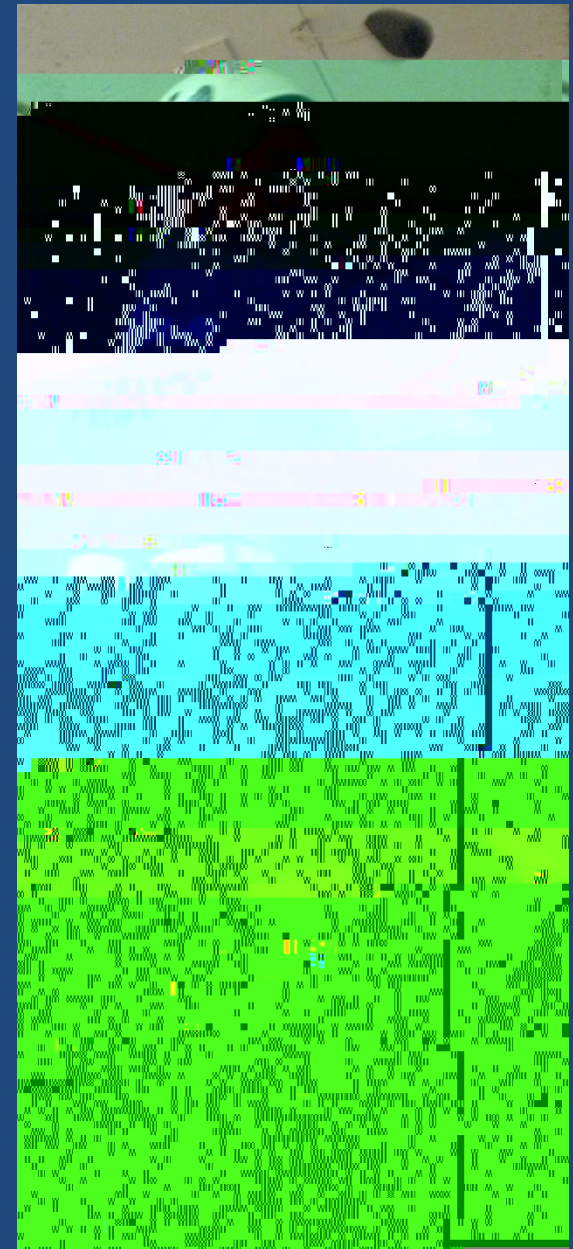

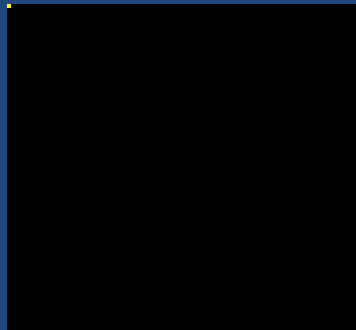

Comparable Performance (District determines comparable performance)	PS7's performance is at least equal to that of other schools students would attend	Fourth highest performing school in SCUSD by API

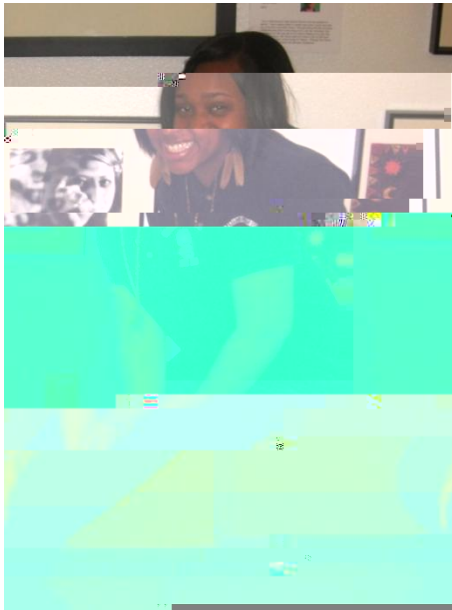
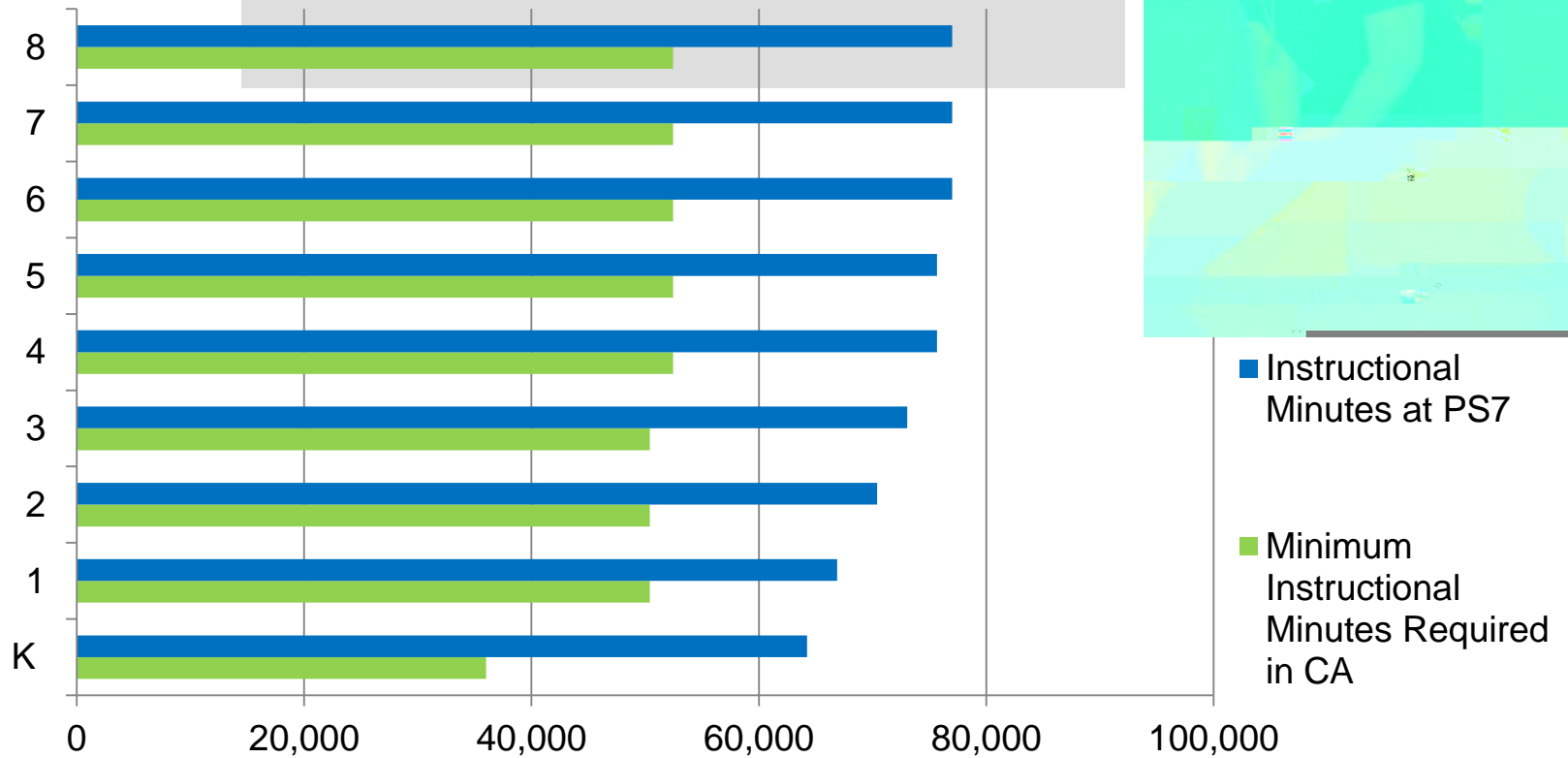
Choice and Commitment

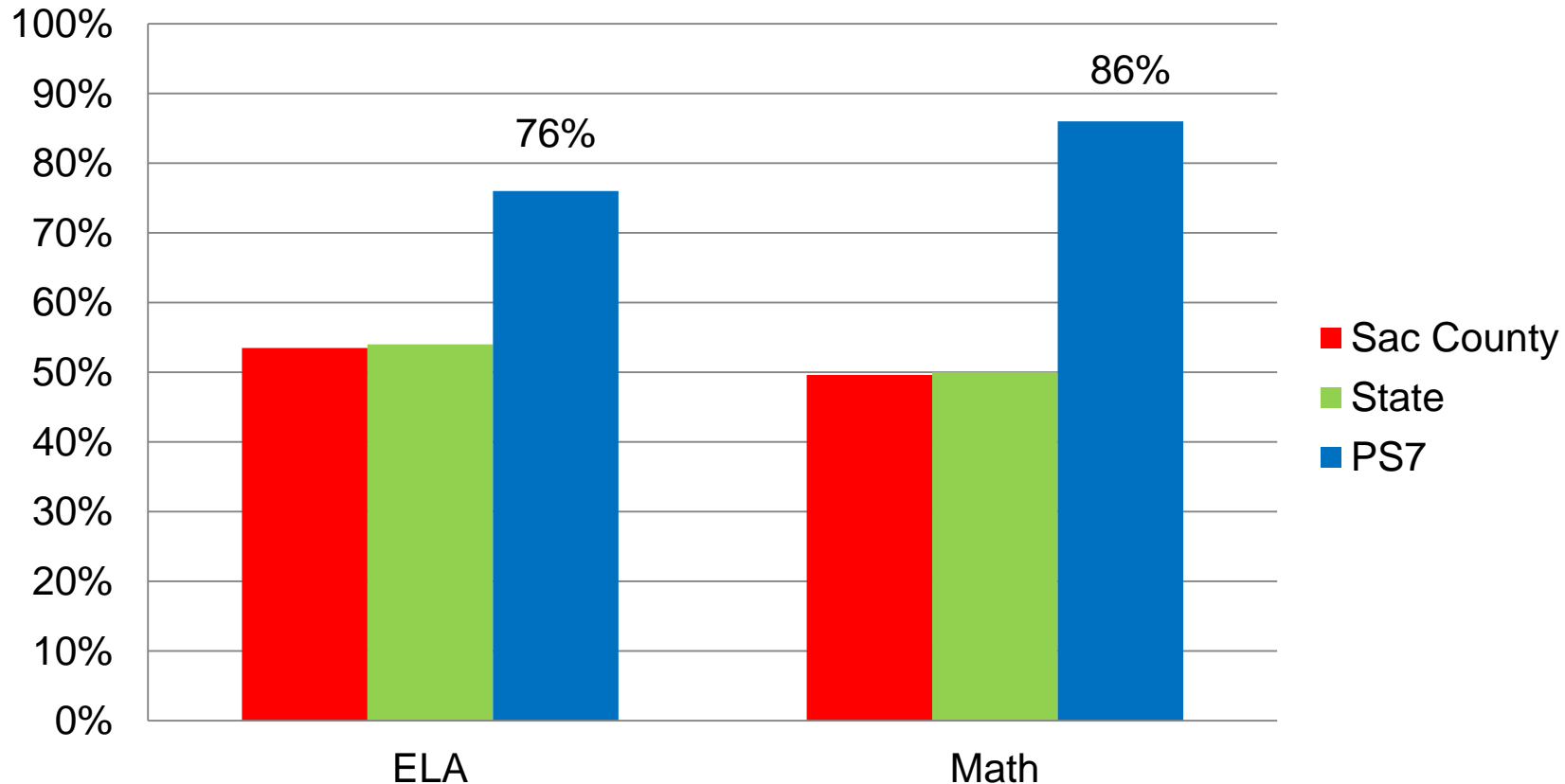

PS7 students in all grades outperform students across the state of California in ELA (reading) and math. Below are the percent of students proficient or advanced in each.

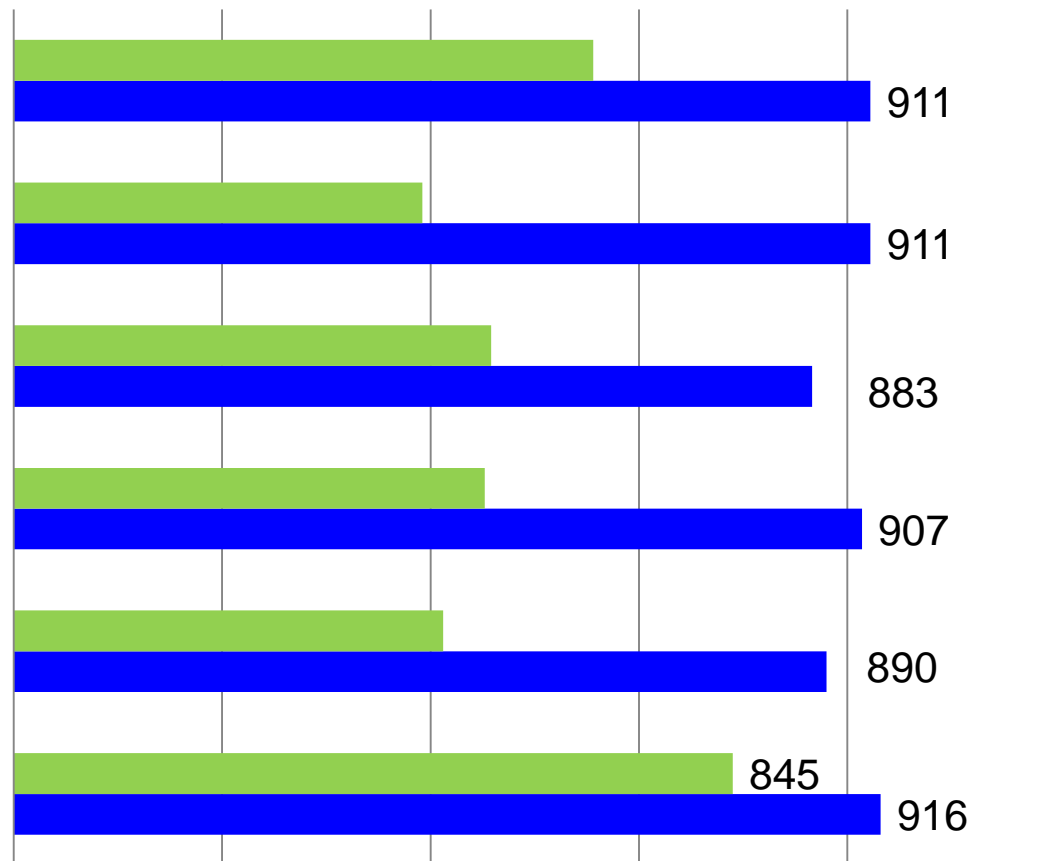




API Growth

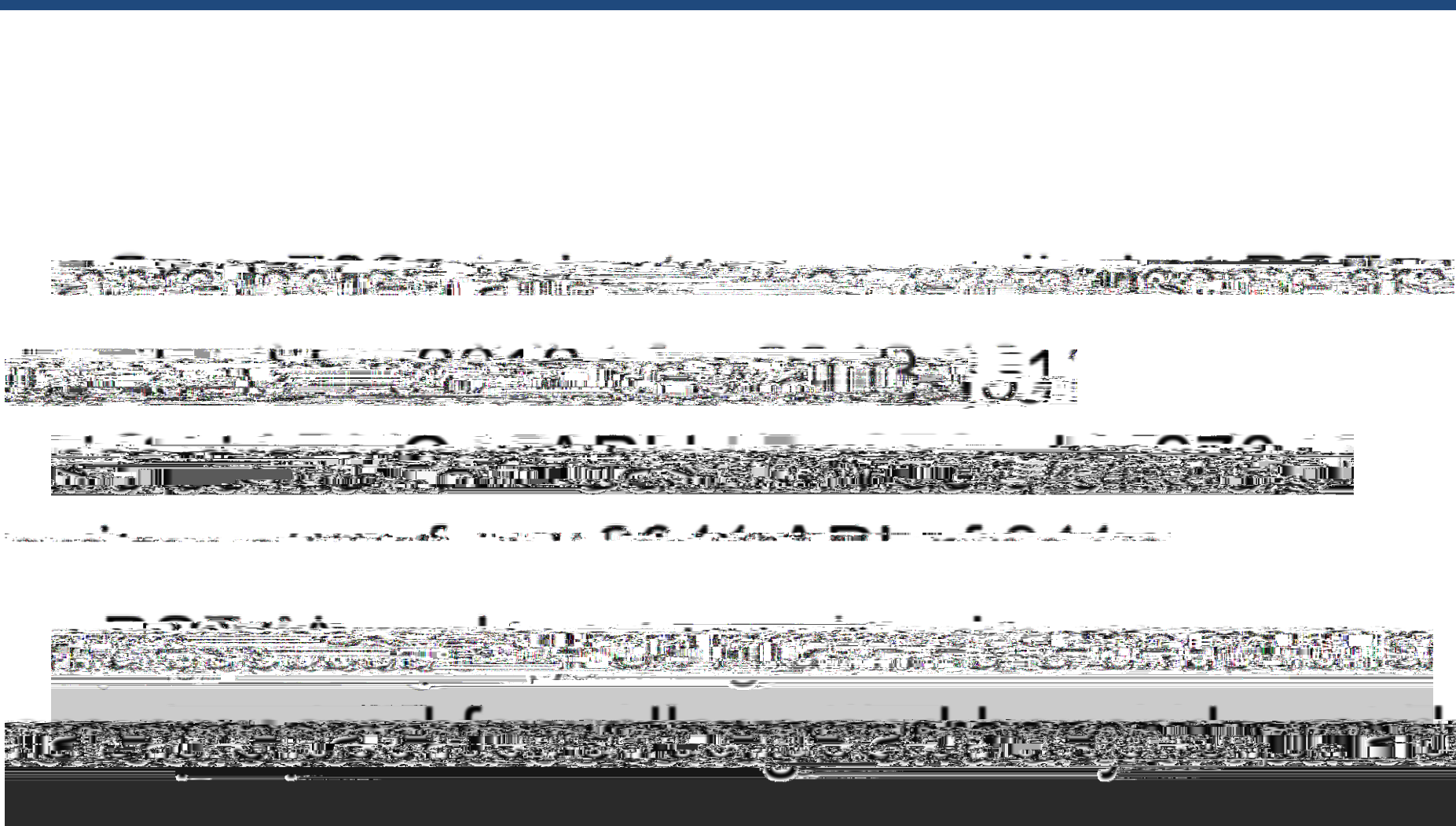
PS7 students participate in various experiences that extend beyond the basic classroom skills and subjects
