Nothing in this MOU shall supersede or conflict with Article 7 - Leaves of Absence in the parties' Collective Bargaining Agreement and specifically, Section 12.2.10 ("Quarantine") which states:

Any employee not personally or directly involved in the day's activities, employee's time be charged to the public.

For purposes paid and unpaid.

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The District shall vaccinated by the parties to the Union's security.

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This MOU applies to the 2021-2022 school year only and is not intended to establish a precedent or past practice. If the State of California or Federal Government institutes COVID-19-related leave legislation, this MOU may be extended to the date provided by the _____ of California or Federal Government and no later upon a mutual agreement by the parties.
